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LESSON PLAN

DAY 1 - Kinds of Trees

Scientists tell us there are over 60,000 different species of trees, from the mighty forest trees, to the fragile ornamental trees. Learn how we relate to trees in God's creation.

The glory of Lebanon shall come to you, the cypress, the plane, and the pine, to beautify the place of my sanctuary, and I will make the place of my feet glorious. ("Isaiah 60:13 ESV)

DAY 2 - Broadleaf Trees

Broadleaf trees are found everywhere in the world. Learn which trees are included in this category, their characteristics, and how they are used in this lesson.

DAY 3 - Needleleaf Trees

There are about 500 kinds of needleleaf trees. Learn why broadleaf trees of the temperate regions are also called deciduous and the characteristics of these types of trees.

DAY 4 - Palm, Pandanus, and Lily Trees

Ever hear of a monocotyledon? There are approximately 60,000 species of monocots. Learn what monocots are and the family of trees that belong to this group. We'll explore one type in more detail in this lesson.

DAY 5 - Cycad Trees and Tree Ferns

They look a lot like palm trees, with a long trunk with no branches and a crown of long, feathery leaves. In this lesson, we'll explore where these trees grow and their use.
