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LESSON PLAN

DAY 1 - Trees in the Bible

The Bible tells us that trees represent strength and prosperity. He shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that brings forth its fruit in its season, whose leaf also shall not wither; and whatever he does shall prosper. - Psalm 1:3

DAY 2 - What are Trees?

Learn the four ways a tree is different than other plants. Everything God made on each day of creation was distinctly different and made in a certain order. This lesson explains why.

DAY 3 - Main Categories of Trees

While there are many kinds of trees, most trees belong to one of two main groups. This lesson teaches what those groups are and their unique characteristics.

DAY 4 - Uses of Wood

Each year millions of trees in forests are cut down. They are then sent to sawmills and then sold to manufacturers and used to make many useful products. Learn the various uses of wood in this lesson.

DAY 5 - Tree Conservation

Trees play a very useful part in the conservation of our earth. Learn the various ways trees help conserve soil and water, and how they help to balance the gases in our atmosphere.
